Location:

Limestone College– in Gaffney, SC. Located conveniently off I 85 between Charlotte and Atlanta.
Washington and Lee University– in Lexington, VA. Located conveniently off of I-81, 45 miles north of Roanoke and 150 miles southwest of Washington, DC.

Air Travel:

To get to Washington & Lee University campers would fly into Roanoke Airport. To get to Limestone College campers would fly into Greenville, SC. Transportation to and from the Roanoke and Greenville airports is provided for a \$40 fee. (due May 15th) When booking flights, plan to arrive prior to 2:00pm on Thursday July 9th or 11:00am on Thursday July 23rd. Departures should be scheduled after 12:00pm on the check-out day.

Commuters:

Participate in the full camp program from registration to checkout. Commuters will attend from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm and receive lunch and dinner.

Tuition/Fees:

\$400 Overnight, \$300 commuter, \$50 refundable key deposit, and if necessary \$40 Transportation fee.
